How to submit an erratum or errata to a previously published paper in the AAAI digital Library.

If an error is discovered in a previously published paper in the AAAI digital library, including AAAI and AAAI-affiated conference proceedings, it is possible to request the addition of an erratum to the paper. To do so, the process is as follows:

- Provide a textual description of the erratum/errata using the latex template provided here: https://www.aaai.org/Publications/Templates/AuthorKit23.zip
- Submit your request to the AAAI Publication Committee at ec-pub-comm@aaai.org.
- In your request, identify the paper's authors, title, publication venue, and its DOI (which can be found by locating it in the AAAI Digital Library).
- The request should cc all authors of the paper, to indicate that there is consensus on the on the technical error(s) and their correction(s)
- Submit the latex source file describing the erratum/errata as an attachment to the request

Upon receipt of the request, it will be reviewed and if there is any further clarification required it will be communicated to the corresponding author. Once the review process is complete, the final submitted textual description will be prepended to the electronic version of the paper in the AAAI digital library.
